When the group began with 14 members in 1916, volunteers raised money for the Red Cross, YWCA scholarships and free ambulance service for children with tuberculosis. TAAP supported hospitals and schools during the Great Depression and bought war bonds during World War II. Eyeglass purchases began in 1936 with regular contributions beginning in 1953. The scholarship program began in 1962. Since 1967, scholarships and the eyeglass fund have been our two philanthropies.
